









Use the sliders to indicate how engaged you were by the guest speakers *O=not* engaged *5=very* engaged




Use the sliders below to indicate the usefulness of workshop topics below.... O=not useful 5=very useful





How much has this experience impacted


How knowledgeable are you about how to: O=not knowledgable 5=very knowledgable

O=disagree 5=strongly agree




How much has your Changemaker Institute experience impacted the following:
